**The aim of the conference:**

The overall aim of this multi-disciplinary conference is to bring together specialist from different countries and branches of science, academics and expert practitioners, in order to present their research and practical results, to promote an interdisciplinary dialog on topics related to the issue of addictions, alcoholism and all other addiction, psychosocial, historical and therapeutical issue, to stimulate addiction study and to inspire and encourage new policies and more effective practice in the field.

**Topics of the conference:**

We welcome original research papers, presentations on topics including, but not limited to, the following areas:

1. History of alcohol and other drugs/other addictions, concerning their production/practice, using and addiction;
2. Sociological, historical, psychological and medical patterns in the addictive behavior;
3. Cultural and spiritual issues in addiction; the multicultural and transcultural perspectives;
5. Social control and public policy concerning alcohol and other drugs/other addictions, in regards to their production, trade, consumption, addiction (prevention, therapy, rehabilitation);
6. Good practice models in the addiction approaching; old and new challenges;
7. Prevention, therapy, rehabilitation and social-professional re-integration in addictions.
8. New drugs and new other addictions in the contemporary world.

**Conference format:**

The conference will run over three days. The program will feature a plenary section keynote lectures and specific sections presentations will run for 15 minutes to be followed by 10 minutes of questions, answers and discussion.

**-Application form and abstract submission deadline: till October, 15, 2014.**

The application form is needed to include, in the following order: a) Name of the author(s); b) Title (Mr., Ms., MA-MSc, PhD Cand., PhD, As. Prof. PhD, Asc. Prof. PhD, Prof. PhD); c) Presenter(s); d) Email; e) Affiliation (Institution), position and country; f) Title of the presentation; g) Accomodation: yes/no; h) Planning date of arrival and depature; i) Participation & registration fee: one (co)author(s) or how many and who; j) Abstract.

Abstracts (200-300 words), in English language, is required following this order:

i) author(s); ii) affiliation; iii) email address; iv) title of abstract; v) up to 10 keywords; vi) body of abstract (objectives, conceptual-theoretical background, methodology, results).

E-mails should be entitled: 6<sup>th</sup> Addiction Conf.- Application and Abstract.

Please use plain text (Times Roman 12) and abstain from using any special formatting and characters.

Applications, the abstracts are reviewed by the scientific committee. Applicants will be informed in short time about receipt and the outcome of the review.

**-Informing on receipt of application form and abstract and outcome the review deadline: till October, 25, 2014.**

Participants are required to pay a fee of 40 EUR for each participant /accepted paper; if are two authors and two participants the fee is 75 EUR, if are three or more authors and participants - 35 EUR each one.
