The Scientific Programme of the conference will consist of invited 45-minutes plenary lectures and contributed 20-minutes papers on the related topics.

You are invited to submit a contributed paper by completing **the on-line preliminary registration form until the 1st of July, 2009**. Authors will be notified of acceptance or rejection of the submitted papers by the **accepted papers list** that will be posted on **15 July 2009**.

In case of acceptance, the authors can make their registration. **The registration form** will be available **after 15 July 2009, and has to be completed until 15 August 2009**.

Deadline for submission of full papers is also **15 August 2009**. All the accepted papers submitted in full version until 15 August 2009 will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee for publication in the conference proceedings.

The conference proceedings is included in a special issue of "Acta Universitatis Apulensis" Journal (indexed in Zentralblatt MATH, Mathematical Reviews and classified as B+ by Romanian CNCSIS standards).

The full version of the accepted papers must be typeset in LaTeX and PDF files and sent by e-mail (dbreaz@uab.ro).
